- Before play put the reed in water for 2-3 minutes.
- Generally small clarinet must be oiling 1-2 times in month. Observe your instrument if the wood inside the bore looks dry and grey it requires oiling. If it has a slightly oil sheen than oiling is not necessary. Use if you can linseed oil it is traditional oil for woodwinds instruments
